COVID COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT

With all of the changes in Provincial numbers, Covid numbers and with our first confirmed case in Takla:

Takla Nation is now going to High Alert

What does this mean to Takla community?

School – no students in class, staff to prepare and monitor schoolwork from home

Closure of Admin Office to nonessential workers

Health Centre – Services and appointment by phone only

Contractors must apply to EOC for access to community

Road Checkpoint to begin as soon as possible, locate near TTP

Essential staff can work in Admin and Clinic, remainder to work from home

Store safety protocol is now reduced to 3 visitors at a time, children are counted as 1

Restaurant remains at take out service only

A Non-Resident travel restriction is now in place, requests made to EOC

No gatherings in community until further notice

4 Rooms to be set up at hotel, barrier across hallway, signage on doors. Isolation accommodation available for up to three days to await results of test. If whole house affected family should self isolate in home until tests results received.

We were trying to be respectful of the death in Fort St. James and had misinformation the death was not due to covid but we are still keeping the family in our thoughts.
