Checkpoint Information

- The checkpoint is in place as Takla has moved to a high alert state.
- It is to assist with tracking where people are going to or coming from, this will help us with contact tracing if needed in the future.
 - Contact Tracing - **Contact tracing is the process of identifying all people that a COVID-19 patient has come in contact with in the last two weeks**
 - Contact tracing helps protect you, your family, and your community by: Letting people know they may have been exposed to COVID-19 and should monitor their health for signs and [symptoms](#) of COVID-19. Helping people who may have been exposed to COVID-19 get tested. Asking people to [self-isolate](#) if they have COVID-19 or [self-quarantine](#) if they are a [close contact](#).
- The checkpoint is not a blockade and Takla Landing is not closed to the public.
- Any non-residents need to connect with EOC via the email eocplans@taklafn.ca to request a travel form or a risk assessment form.
- The checkpoint is to ensure Health and Safety of the community members.
- All non-essential travel is discouraged.
