ADULT STUDENT CODE OF ETHICS

As outlined in the Takla Nation Adult and Post-Secondary Education policy, the Nation believes in planned further education, and is willing to share responsibility with students for their success. All adult students sponsored by Takla Nation (TN) and/or supported in community-based programs or post-secondary programs recognize their responsibilities as members of the Nation, with a tradition of respect for lifelong learning and the sharing of knowledge and skills. Students will:

1. Adhere to Takla Nation policy and procedures, and to the policies and procedures of the institution offering the educational program. It is the responsibility of the student to know and understand all relevant policies and procedures.
2. Carry out the student responsibilities as outlined by TN and the educational institution.
3. Respect the authority and structures of TN Chief and Council, TN Administration, and of the educational institutions.
4. Demonstrate the integrity and dignity of TN as a member and a sponsored student while pursuing further education.
5. Demonstrate a constructive approach when working with Takla Nation employees, instructors and staff of institutions. Respect the knowledge and guidance of Education Department staff as they work with you to achieve your goals.
6. Recognize that Takla Nation is committed to a positive, respectful working environment free of bullying and harassment, or discrimination. While supporting the use of social media to discuss opinions and share information respectfully, bullying and harassment of our staff online or in person is not tolerated. Provide constructive criticism and suggestions through proper channels.
7. Do not misuse sponsorship or support funds, including living allowance and travel allowance.

Any failure to abide by these standards is subject to investigation based on Takla Nation policies. Outcomes can include loss of funding or access to Nation services.
