COVID IMPACT NUMBERS

- * As of 21 September ,2021 - **21 Active Cases in community and growing.**
- * Over a 4-week period we went from 1-2 cases per week to over 5 cases per week.
- * We have **40 members** self-monitoring out of a population of 300.
- * Provincially we're at 100 cases per day, The Northern Health Region is the most active.



COMMUNITY SUPPORT

Essentials are being delivered to affected members.

- Medicine – home delivery
- Door to door messaging explaining support from the Nation and the EOC Team.

GATHERINGS

The community is shut down for the next 14 days.

Stay Home!

Visitors to community are NOT welcome during this time.

Visiting neighbors is discouraged outside of your household bubble.

Postponing of Potlatch services, funeral services, and other community events.



VACCINATION

Recommended that all members in Takla Landing to get vaccinated.

Although you may be vaccinated you can still be affected by Covid-19.

- The vaccine does not make you invincible to covid.
- When vaccinated safe covid practices are still required.
- Wear your mask at all times

If you are unwell and showing signs and symptoms, please call 811 or call the health clinic to book an appointment for rapid testing.



ACCESS TO THE COMMUNITY

Visitors to the community are restricted for the next 14 days.

The 2 access roads to the community will be temporarily deactivated leaving only the main road by TTP and the RCMP station open.

Contractors are being monitored through covid testing daily.

Any access to community must be granted through the EOC team application.
